After his discharge from the U.S. Army in 1971, Bob worked in credit management for Emerson Electric Company before starting his surety career in 1977 with SAFECO Insurance Company of America in St. Louis. In 1979, he relocated to Kansas City to establish the Kansas City Surety Branch. Bob moved to Los Angeles in 1981 and took on the role of Regional Commercial Surety Manager. He became the manager of the Sacramento Surety Branch in 1983.

In 1986, Bob left SAFECO to become the Surety Manager for the Sacramento office of Rollins, Burdick, Hunter of Northern California (AON). In 1989, he founded Chartwell Surety & Insurance Agency, which later evolved into Buschmann, Buschmann & Laux Surety Insurance Services, LLC, commonly known as BB&L.

In 2016, Bob sold the book of business formerly known as Buschmann, Buschmann, and Laux Surety Insurance Services to Bender Insurance Solutions. This allowed him to step away from agency management and focus on his accounts and expanding the surety operations of BIS.

Throughout the years, Bob has been actively involved in various volunteer initiatives, including teaching Personnel Economics at the junior high level through the Junior Achievement Program.
